Phonics- (Little-Wandle-Phase 2)

Pupils will recognise all single letter sounds plus *ck*, *ff*, *ll*, *ss*, *zz*, *qu*, *ch*, *sh*, *th*, *ng*, *nk*. Pupils will be able to read and write short words containing the sounds. Pupils will also learn to read tricky words *is*, *l*, *the*, *and*, *as*, *has*, *his*, *her*, *go*, *no*, *to*, *into*, *she*, *he*, *of*, *we*, *me*, *be*.

<u>Maths (NCETM) - Our focus this term will be on the following units:</u>

- ✓ Counting
- ✓ Subitising amounts to 5 (Seeing how many without needing to count)
- ✓ Showing numbers on fingers as quickly as possible to match how many
