Text	The Pirate Cruncher by Jonny Duddle
Unit Enquiry Questions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Which places make up my world?- Are pirates real?
Engage/Hook	Suitcase of pirate related objects - Who do they belong to? What are they? What are they used for? What are they made from?
Outcomes	Pupils will create a 'Wanted' poster for a pirate using Pic Collage (iPad).
Global / National / Local themes	To understand basic crime and punishment in relation to piracy.
Reading	Use passages from 'The Pirate Cruncher' to introduce and develop vocabulary, prediction, retrieval, summarising and inferences.
