Understanding the World - Seasons

- ✓ About everyday changes – weather, environment

Understanding the World - Festivals

- ✓ Pupils will learn about festivals and celebrations such as Bonfire Night, Diwali and Christmas.

Understanding the World-Who am I? What makes me special?

- ✓ Pupils will learn about their personal attributes and identify their features e.g. hair colour, eye colour.
- ✓ Pupils will be able to talk about their likes and dislikes.
